## City Council Meeting Minutes

### City Hall

- 1.) Call to Order  
The Fertile City Council met at 7:00 PM in regular session, March 7, 2006, at Fertile City Hall.
- 2.) Roll Call  
Present were, Council members Melanne Bang, Jeff Berg, Tad Miller, Patrick Renchin, Gail Shropshire, and City Clerk Eddie May. Mayor Joyce Russell was Absent. Tad Miller acted as Mayor Pro-Tem.
- 3.) Minutes Approval  
Berg moved and Renchin 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the February minutes.
- 4.) Discussion on the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary  
The FB&I presented a proposal for a Beer Garden to be located in Rhodes Park for Friday and Saturday. The Garden will be fenced in. ID's will be checked at the entrance. The Budget was adopted according to what was published in the Forest City Summit. Copies of the budget are available upon request at City Hall. Berg Moved, Renchin 2<sup>nd</sup> to adopt the City Budget for Fiscal Year 2006-2007. Consensus was unanimous. Adoption carried.

  - Billings will be printed this month through QuickBooks. The format of the bill will be similar to previous bills.
