City of Fertile

City Council Meeting Minutes April 19, 2011 - 7:00 PM, City Hall

Call to Order & Roll Call

- Present were: Mayor Joyce Russell; Council Members: Jeff Berg, Penny Miller, Tad Miller, Cindy Peters and Pat Renchin; Maintenance Manager Buck Russell and City Clerk Eddie May.
- Cindy motioned, Jeff 2nd to approve the March Minutes. Carried.

First Gabrielson, ICAP Insurance

- Jay LeFevre introduced himself to the council and asked if there were any questions regarding the City's policy. The highlights of the policy were outlined, including: our premium credit for longevity, \$2 million liability coverage, and \$500 deductible.
- The City pays for coverage of the Library and Fire Department, as well as for the new building, water & sewer plants, ball fields, park, bridges, and streets.
- Jay suggested that the City receive a certificate of homeowner's insurance from everyone who rents the new facility.
- Jay mentioned that adding security cameras will not lower the City's insurance premium, but would definitely detour vandalism damage.

Worth County Sheriff's Department – K9 Unit

- Deputy Rick Anderson and Deputy Dan Fank asked the Council if
 they could use the new building as a training location for their K9
 unit. They currently use Woodharbor, Worth County Court House,
 Isaac Walton League, Brcka Construction, and other buildings in
 Worth County. The more buildings they can use, the better trained
 the unit is.
- They would enter the buildings, make sure they are empty, and then commence training. The dogs will find hidden drugs, bomb materials, and people during their training exercises. The training could happen any time, day or night, with no set schedule.
- Tad motioned, Pat 2nd to approve access for k9 training to the new building on Eagle Avenue as well as the maintenance shed on Main Street, and the new Fire Department (if they approve also). Motion Carried.

Community Center / City Hall Project

- The City was awarded \$102,805.00 from the Worth County
 Development Authority (WCDA), non-profit arm of the Diamond
 Joe Casino, for phase II of the project. This phase will consist of
 demolition, re-framing, plumbing and electrical. Construction will
 begin as soon as Friday, April 21st.
- Pat motioned, Jeff 2nd to appoint City Clerk Eddie May as the project manager for phase II of the project. Motion Carried.
- The City will apply for Phase III this fall, to include heating/cooling, sheet-rocking, finishing, kitchen equipment, cabinetry, etc.
- The Community Center Committee will meet on Tuesday the 26th at 7:00 at City Hall to discuss Phase III, as well as the Library portion of the project. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Mayor's Report

• Mayor Russell attended a storm spotter's class on March 16th. On April 9th, Fire Chief Josh Miller spotted a tornado west of town. The siren was sounded for 10 minutes. The siren is primarily intended to warn people who are outside of their homes, alerting them to take cover. It is assumed that people inside their homes have alternative warning systems, including TV, Internet, Radio and/or a Midland NOAH system. NOAH systems are available at HyVee West in

- Mason City for \$15. They are also available for free during certain times of the year.
- A yield sign has gone missing on the east side of town. A new one has been ordered.
- Alliant Energy replaced 3 street lights. All lights should be working.
- Crescent Moon has opened up the porta-poties around town.
- The FCC is requiring that all Fire Departments replace their radios to work on a different frequency. Fertile will need radios and pagers for 14 volunteers by 2013. The new radios cost \$800 each.
- Basic Materials has given a quote to add 2" of road rock along the
 east side of the new building, as well as adding 3" of 1.5" clean rock
 to the south of the new building. Mayor Russell will look into the cost
 of adding a layer of fabric to keep the rock from sinking into the dirt.
- Plunkett Pest Control has given a quote to the City for spraying the new building. They will spray the City Hall portion only, until the community center portion of the building is complete.
- On Saturday May 28th, from 8am to 3pm, Waste Management will
 drop off two large dumpsters for Fertile's City Wide Clean-Up Day.
 Residents will receive a ticket in the mail which they will need to
 present at the time of dumping in order to use the dumpsters. No
 appliances, electronics or tires will be accepted. Details will be
 arriving in the mail within the next two weeks.
- The second phase of the Housing Program has kicked off. Homes at: 304 West Washington, 506 West Main Street, and 209 East Main Street will receive up to \$25,000 each for approved renovations. The City intends on continuing to a third phase and continuing to apply for the housing grants for additional phases.
