City Council Meeting Minutes June 19, 2018 - 7:00 PM, City Hall Call to Order & Roll Call:

- Present were: Mayor Joyce Russell; Council Members: Cindy Peters, Nick Bailey, Ron Rachut and Holly Lovik-Hanna; City Clerk Wendy Lunning and Maintenance Manager Steve Roberts. Absent Tad Miller.
- Nick motioned, Holly 2nd to approve the minutes of the May 29 Public Hearing. Unanimous
- *Ron motioned, Cindy 2nd to accept agenda.* Unanimous. Agendas are posted at City Hall, at the Library, and at the Post Office, 24 hours in advance of each Council Meeting. If you wish to be on the Agenda, please contact City Hall two days before the meeting.

Firework Permits:

Firework Permits are available at City Hall for use within Fertile
City Limits. Fireworks can be displayed on private property from 9
am to 10 pm June 1 through July 8 with the exception that the
Saturday & Sunday before and after the Fourth of July may be set
of until 11 pm. Penalties may applied if residents do not comply.

Ordinance Amendment – Animal Control:

- Joyce proposed Ordinance Amendment for bothersome animals, livestock, exotic pets and the limits on the number of animals kept that had been approved by the City Attorney. Council decided to table this and will remain with ordinances in place.
 - 1. All dogs 6 months or older shall be vaccinated against rabies.
 - 2. No owner or person shall permit animal to run at large.
 - 3. It is unlawful for any person to permit animal to commit a
 - 4. Any animal found at large shall be seized and impounded.
 - 5. Dangerous animals are prohibited.

Private Drive – Steve & Rhonda Prescott:

 The Private Drive Keep Out sign will be removed. City of Fertile will continue to maintain Park Street.

City Maintenance Report:

- Steve & Buck took plow truck to Fort Dodge for repair.
- Sewer draw down is requiring more test to be sent to LGI.
- Flag Poles have been received at the Community Center and are ready to install.
- Steve has painted the volleyball poles, put up new net, spray and drug the sand at the volleyball court.
- Steve posted the embargo signs on East Main Street.
- Steve purchased fuel tank for back of pick up.
- Steve has been working on some residential water meters that have not been working properly.
- Steve replaced 5 damaged trash cans with new ones.
- Steve has been cleaning up sticks at the park from storm damage.
- Water plant went down and Steve manually filled water tower every 4 hours for several days until parts receive and replaced.
- Cindy motioned, Ron 2nd to approve the City Maintenance report.

Mayor's Report:

- Steve & Buck repaired siding at the library that blew off in wind storm.
- Thank you, Sue McColloch, for planting the flowers in the new pots at the library.

- Holly motioned, Cindy 2nd to appoint Ron Rachut as Winn Worth Betco Representative. Unanimous
- Joyce contact Worth County Sherriff to sound tornado siren and was not done. Dispatchers have since received additional training. Protocol has changed and the tornado siren will be sounding if and of the following occur.
 - 1. Mayor notifies Worth County Sherriff.
 - 2. Trained tornado spotter notifies Worth County Sherriff.
 - 3. A tornado watch turns into a tornado Warning issued by the National Weather Service.

A tornado warning issued by national weather forecasting agencies to warn the public that severe thunderstorms with tornadoes are imminent or occurring. It can be issued after a tornado or funnel cloud has been spotted by the public, storm chasers, emergency management or law enforcement, or more commonly if there are radar indications of tornado formation.

- Thank you, Doug Petersburg, for fixing the parking at the Fertile Lutheran church and ball diamonds.
- Pepsi has brought a pop machine and is located at the library.
- The City Sign has been replaced and is erected at the Community Center
- Joyce ordered City of Fertile decal for Steve's ATV to be used for city maintenance as needed.
- Antenna's at the water tower are being worked on. The Fire & Tornado antennas are working properly. Contractors are working with Worth County Sherriff for repairs of the Law enforcement antenna
- Heartland started blacktopping the parking lot at the Community Center
- Hail damage has been reported at the Library on the roof.
- *Cindy motioned, Nick 2nd to approve the mayor's report.* Unanimous.

City Clerk's Report

- There will be a change in how the water is taxed as of 07/01/2018. There
 will no longer be sales tax on water, but a 6% Water Excise Tax will be
 charged instead. WET funds will be distributed by the State of Iowa into
 quality infrastructure fund and the water quality assistance fund.
